“Since our last town hall meeting, we’ve been working on additional studies for the proposed route alternatives advanced from the Feasibility Study,” said Allen Messer, Director of Engineering for the City of Hamilton. “We’ve also looked into possible changes that came up during the study process or were suggested by community members. We wanted a deeper understanding of the options available to us. We didn’t just want to know how well they would work, but also what their impacts would be.”

BCTID Director Dan Corey added: “No matter how we shape it, this project

goes through a heavily populated area, so we need to do this right. While we need to have a strong grasp on the data, expected benefits and impacts, we also listen to community input. This plays a key role in fine-tuning the project and decision-making. Our goal for the June 24th meeting is to share the most up-to-date information with the public and gather their thoughts before we decide on next steps.”

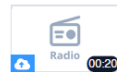

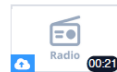

RECOMMENDED PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

The City of Hamilton and Butler County Transportation Improvement District's (BCTID) recommendation for the NHX route is shown in the map below.

This Recommended Preferred Alternative is not final and is being shared with the public for review and comment. Once the public comment period concludes on August 8, the City and BCTID, working in coordination with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), will determine if any modifications are needed.

The route shown above may be adjusted as the project continues to be developed in more detail and as input is received from the public, regulatory agencies and ODOT. As such, specific impacts to properties are not yet known.

Later this year, recommendations for the preferred route will be included in an Environmental Assessment (EA) report which will:

- Document studies completed and their findings
- Identify measures to be taken to minimize impacts
- Summarize comments received from the public
- Formally submit the Recommended Preferred Alternative for approval

Once complete, the EA will be shared with the public again for review and discussion during a Public Hearing (likely to be held early next year) before a final routing decision is made.

ICE, Big Beautiful Bill among headlines in region

A group of pastors are asking Butler County commissioners to void the contract the county sheriff has with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and exit the deportation business.

Pastor Caleb Kragt of the West Charleston Church of the Brethren in Tipp City spoke about one of his parishioners, Armando Reyes Rodriguez, 42, who was "scooped up" by ICE in April and is now in the jail.

He told the commissioners that Reyes Rodriguez, of Dayton, is living here with permission from the federal government and his wife and son are currently in the process of getting asylum from Honduras.

Butler County Sheriff Richard K. Jones had an ICE contract for housing detainees awaiting immigration hearings from 2003 until June 2021, when he canceled it because he did not agree with the Biden administration's regulations. Butler County commissioners approved an amendment to the contract the sheriff has with the U.S. Marshals Service to add ICE prisoners earlier this year.

There is a pending lawsuit filed in 2020 in U.S. District Court in Cincinnati by two refugees, Bayong Brown Bayong and Admed Adem, who claim they were repeatedly beaten and threatened during their ICE detention.

In Butler County Jones previously told this news outlet that the men — both no longer housed at the jail — were noncompliant while in the jail and appropriate use of force was used.

When asked about canceling the sheriff's ICE contract, Commissioner Don Dixon had this to say: "We don't tell the sheriff what to do with the jail, he runs the jail. He's the highest elected official in Butler County for law enforcement."

What's happening in Southern Ohio?

■ Trump budget moves

to Senate: The One Big Beautiful Bill Act passed the U.S. House before Memorial Day. Only two Republican broke ranks with the White House to vote against the plan — one of them was U.S. Rep. Warren Davidson, R-Troy. "While I love many things in the bill, promising someone else will cut spending in the future does not cut spending," Davidson said, expressing concerns about Republicans creating a larger deficit. Also voicing disappointment with Trump's tax and budget package was Elon Musk, who dillies how the bill is expected to drive up the

national deficit.

■ DOGE and Musk: Musk announced his departure from his government role this week. Budget-cutting teams led by Musk and his Department of Government Efficiency have been slashing federal employment, programs and properties since January. Congress still hasn't voted on any DOGE cuts. Republican U.S. Rep. Dave Taylor, of Clermont County, said Congress must "actively codify DOGE's findings to ensure the responsible use of taxpayer dollars."

■ Baby balloons and NATO: One of the most

famous — and to others, infamous — balloons in the world came to Dayton, depicting Trump as a big baby. The "Trump Baby" balloon was inflated on East Second Street downtown on Saturday morning as part of protest activities during the NATO Parliamentary Assembly, which wrapped up in Dayton on Monday.

■ Dayton law firm: A federal judge struck down an executive order that sought to sanction a law firm with a Dayton presence. The Trump administration's executive order aimed to mandate the suspension of attorney security clearances and bar employees from accessing federal buildings.

■ WilmerHale: WilmerHale employs roughly 230 workers at its location in Miami Twp. WilmerHale is the former employer of Robert S. Mueller III, who

conducted an investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election.

■ Other federal updates

■ Tariffs: A federal court on Wednesday blocked Trump's sweeping tariffs under an emergency-powers law. What isn't clear is whether his administration will respond to the ruling by pausing all of its emergency power tariffs in the interim. But for now, Trump might not have the leverage of import taxes to influence

the world economy as he had intended, since doing so would require congressional approval. Trump earlier this week said he would delay a threatened 50% tariff on goods from the European Union to July. The EU's chief trade negotiator said he had "good calls" with Trump administration officials and that the EU was "fully committed" to reaching a trade deal.

■ Trump at Arlington: Trump paid tribute to fallen service members during a Memorial Day ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery on Monday, in an address that honored the "great, great warriors." The president began the day with an all-caps social media post that called ex-President Joe Biden the "scum that spent the last four years trying to destroy our country through warped radical left minds."

■ Harvard: Trump has asked federal agencies to cancel roughly \$100 million in contracts with Harvard University. The government has already canceled more than \$2.6 billion in federal research grants for the Ivy League school. Harvard has pushed back on the Trump administration's demands for changes to several of its policies. Trump also called for a 15% cap on international students at Harvard — international students make up more than a quarter of the student body.

Chamber can test effects of extreme conditions

In its quest to dive deeper into the realms of human physiology, the Air Force Research Laboratory has a rain-making tool on Wright-Patterson Air Force Base.

A rain-making, heat-inducing, freeze-creating Research Environmental Chamber, or REC, is to be exact.

APRIL 7th Human Performance Wing and business leaders cut the ribbon on the REC on Tuesday in Wright-Patterson's Area B, celebrating a research tool advocates say will help Air Force, Navy and civilian researchers better understand how people and gear withstand the extremes of heat, cold and humidity.

The REC joins AFRL's Research Altitude Chamber, centrifuge and Naval Medical Research Unit's Kraken and Darwin Chamber as tools to help researchers go deeper into the realms of human performance.

Looking like a stainless steel oven big enough to accommodate four adults, the \$1.4 million chamber allows researchers to also test how humans and gear react

to the exposure of certain non-hazardous chemicals, said Jennifer Schwaneck Kerr, a senior research scientist and contractor at AFRL.

"One of the capabilities that this chamber addresses is the

ability to introduce non-hazardous chemicals, to test environmental chemical sensors in a controlled setting," she said. "We also have the ability to make it rain, which is unique to this chamber."

The altitude and Darwin chambers, also on the base, can manipulate temperature changes, she noted. But the REC offers faster temperature ramping and more stable humidity as well as the ability to create up to six inches of rain

in an hour.

"It's a feature," she said. As long as Airmen are deployed to deserts and frozen tundras, these are questions that need to be answered. In January 1968, a B-52 Stratofortress bomber crashed in Greenland after the crew ejected, sending Airmen into the winter darkness to search for radioactive materials from nuclear warheads that had been on board the plane. (There was no nuclear detonation.)

"The idea is that we don't always operate at room temperature, which is where we test a lot of our equipment," said Schwaneck Kerr. Commercial, off-the-shelf equipment may be tested as low as 10 to 20 degrees

below zero. But as she put it: "That is not our operational scenario."

The REC can sink to -60 degrees F. The Air Force needs to know its gear can perform in those extreme environments.

The chamber was built by Russell's Technical Products, of Michigan.

"What we have here in this audience represents the team that makes us successful," Brig. Gen. Robert Bogart, 7th Human Performance Wing commander, said at Tuesday's ribbon-cutting event.

Based at Wright-Patterson, AFRL performs Air Force-focused research with more than 12,500 employees across the world.
